Course Objectives:

In Multimedia Presentations, students will learn the tools necessary to create amazing videos of various topics and stories. Students will work on creating a morning news channel as well as a lip dub for the entire school. Students will film various activities throughout the year and create a highlight video. Students will also participate in the 10 day film challenge at the end of the year testing their skills from everything they have learned throughout the year such as composition, lighting, framing, script writing, editing, color, and editing.

Assignment Type	Percentage	Description
Homework	30%	Having homework done on time.
Projects	20%	Each week you will have a project(s) to do.
Presentations	10%	You will have presentations throughout the marking period.
Quizzes	10%	You will have quizzes either written or hands on projects.
Tests/Portfolio	30%	You will have major projects that are considered tests. You will have to keep an online portfolio of all of your work.

Necessary Materials:

Digital Camera (Not a Cell Phone) – Mandatory

Students must get at least a 8gb Flash Drive – Mandatory

Video Camera - Recommended not Mandatory

SD Card – 16GB

BYOD – If you have a mac Laptop or PC Laptop bringing this in would be a benefit to you and the class.

Procedures and Policies:

1. Students must arrive on time. If they do not arrive on time they must have a pass to get into class.
2. Students are to treat all computer, camera, and equipment as if it were their own. They will have to sign an acceptable use policy for the equipment to be used. If any damage is done to the equipment they will have to purchase whatever is necessary in order to fix the equipment.
